Our ability to meet the goals set out in the Quality Policy as detailed above and to ensure that it supports the Organisation's strategic direction, will be reviewed annually at the Management Review Meeting, and updated if necessary.

Quality Objectives will be defined as part of the annual Business Plan and will provide an input for the setting of specific measurable Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) for each core business process.

Senior Management ensures that the Quality Policy is communicated to all employees. Senior Management reviews the Quality Policy at each Annual Management Review meeting to determine the policy's continuing suitability for the Organisation.
